CALL FOR PAPERS

JORES is pleased to announce its first call for articles to be published in December, 2012.

INSTRUCTION FOR AUTHORS: JORES is a multidisciplinary journal which publishes cutting-edge empirical or scientific articles that have not been previously published or are being considered for publications elsewhere. The journal welcomes articles that meet the general criteria of scientific excellence.

TYPES OF ARTICLES

1. **EMPIRICAL STUDIES:** Articles that present original empirical research pertinent to the author's area of specialization. These should describe new and carefully confirmed findings, and experimental procedures given in sufficient details for others to verify
2. **SHORT COMMUNICATION:** a short communication is suitable for recording the results of complete small investigations or giving details of new modes or hypotheses, innovative teaching methods or research methods, techniques and apparatus.
3. **SQUIBS AND RESEARCH REPORTS:** These articles should present research on ongoing theoretical projects or subsets of data making significant contributions that are time sensitive
4. **ETHNOGRAPHIC (SITUATIONAL) REPORT:** An Ethnographic (situational) report is a descriptive report or study of a current issue focusing on a research of a national issue of educational interest.

SUBMISSION STYLE : JORES accepts electronic submission of articles provided that the texts, tables, and figures are included in a single Microsoft word and pdf (preferably, in Arial font) files, 12 point. This should be sent to the following email addresses: joresaocoed@gmail.com; joresaocoed@yahoo.com .

The **cover-page** should contain the postal address(es), email address(es) and phone number(s) of the corresponding author(s). The **Abstract** should not exceed 150 words in length. It must be informative and self-explanatory. It must briefly present the topic, state the scope of the experiments, indicate significant data and point out major findings and recommendations. Complete sentences, active verbs and the third person should be used. The abstract should be written in the past tense. Standard nomenclature should be used and abbreviations should be avoided. No literature should be cited in the abstract. The abstract must be accompanied by 3 to 10 keywords. The **introduction** should provide a clear statement of the research problem. The introduction should also include purpose or objectives of the study, research questions or hypotheses as well as proposed approach or research method. The **approach** and the entire work should be what colleagues elsewhere will understand and can apply in similar situation(s) under similar condition(s). **Plagiarism** is **NOT** allowed. Enhanced subheadings should be used. Authors should thoroughly **proofread** the work for grammatical errors and other related matters that may discredit the work before submission. Submission of a manuscript guarantees that the work has not been published or is being considered for publication elsewhere. In **the body** of the manuscript, abbreviations should be spelled out and introduced in parenthesis the first time they are used. Generally, no reference should exceed 10 years. Older publications should be included only for historical purposes or significance or when no new work has been published on the subject in the last 10 years.

In addition to the **electronic copy**, JORES expects the author(s) to also mail **three hard copies** of the articles together with a **virus-free CD-Rom** and **₦3,000** or \$ 25 to the following address:

INSTRUCTION FOR AUTHORS: Generally, articles should not exceed 12 pages including tables, diagramme, references, appendixes etc. Articles in excess of the required page limit will attract **₦ 1,000** or \$ 10 per excess page. The acceptable reference style is the APA 6th edition.

VETTING FEE: All articles must be accompanied with a receipt of **₦3,000** or \$ 25 vetting fee payable at:

REVIEW /EDITING PROCESS: All articles are peer-reviewed by qualified international reviewers/editors. Decisions will be made as quickly as possible. The journal strives to return reviewers'/editors' comments to author(s) within three weeks. Author(s) whose articles are judged publishable must work on the comments and return corrected and final copies of the article(s) as follows: 1 hard copy, a virus-free CD-Rom copy, and an electronic copy. These should reach JORES Editorial Board at the addresses above within three weeks if the article(s) must be published. Late submission is not encouraged.

ACCEPTANCE: Articles are accepted for publication once all corrections and amendments have been made and the article(s) ha(s/ve) been resent to JORES within a stipulated time and according to specified guidelines. The author(s) will inform JORES by an email that **₦25,000** or \$ 200 publication fee has been paid into JORES account.

COPIES FOR AUTHOR(S): a copy of the journal edition that contains the name(s) of the author(s) will be mailed to the corresponding author(s) upon publication. More copies of the journal may be obtained upon payment of **₦ 2000** or \$ 15 to JORES account.
